Treasurer's Report July, August September '93 Fiscal Year 4th Quarter

Northwind's 4th quarter showed its highest sales of the year, at \$21,100.00, bringing our sales for the year to \$77,715.00. In spite of the strong sales, we did show a net loss for the 4th quarter of \$411.00, bringing our year-to-date loss to \$1254.00, and our retained earnings at year's end to (\$2116.00).

The breakdown of sales and net profit (loss) for

fiscal year '93 looks like this:

Overall it was a difficult year for the co-op, and it shows in the sales (down \$5000.00 from last year) and in the bottom line. But our 3rd and 4th quarters do show an improvement from the first half of the year and our plans are to continue in this direction.
